ARTICLE V. Officers

Section 1. Officers

The Officers shall be a President, a President-Elect, a Past-President, a Presidential Advisor, a Secretary, a Treasurer, and an Executive Director (the Executive Director is a non-voting position). These officers comprise the Executive Committee. No person may hold more than one office at the same time. The Officers other than the Executive Director must be Full Members, Exempt Life Members, Contributing Life Members, or Academic members. Officers shall serve a term of one (1) year, excepting the Secretary and Treasurer. The Secretary may serve two (2) terms consecutively. The Treasurer serves a two (2) year term, and may be appointed to an additional two (2) year term. With the approval of a majority of a quorum of the Board, the President appoints the Presidential Advisor and Secretary every year, and the Treasurer every other year. With the approval of a majority of a quorum of the Board, these appointments may be made by the President-Elect in anticipation of ascending to the President during the last (2) two months of his/her President-Elect year. The Board may remove any Officer at any time, with or without cause, by a majority vote of the total Board.

Section 2. <u>Executive Director</u>

The Executive Director shall be appointed by the Board of Directors, and shall be employed as the Board may determine. The Executive Director's performance will be reviewed on an annual basis by the Executive Committee.

Section 3. <u>Compensation</u>

Officers, other than the Executive Director, shall not receive any compensation for serving as Officers.
